

**Bachelor of Business Administration with
Bachelor of Commerce - Accounting (Professional Accounting)
Recommended Program 2008 Intake**

This is a suggested sequence of units which may guide you in planning your academic program for 2008. It is your responsibility to check prerequisites and ensure that your program satisfies the University requirements for the award of a Bachelor of Business Administration with the degree of Bachelor of Commerce – Accounting as set out in the 2008 Handbook.

Students transferring to Macquarie University who wish to have qualifications obtained at other tertiary institutions considered for accreditation by the professional accounting bodies (CPA Australia and ICAA) are reminded that it is the student's responsibility to ensure that these qualifications are accepted by the professional bodies.

With effect from January 2005 CPA Australia has set a limit on two conceded passes (PCs) in a three year Bachelor degree. Additional limits apply to conceded passes in core accounting and business units.
