

**B COMMERCE**  
**Finance (FNN06)**

This is a suggested sequence of units which may guide you in planning your academic program for 2008. It is your responsibility to check pre-requisites and ensure that your program satisfies the University requirements for the award of a Bachelor Degree as set out in the 2008 Handbook.

Students transferring to Macquarie University who wish to have qualifications obtained at other tertiary institutions considered for accreditation by the professional accounting bodies (CPA Australia and ICAA) are reminded that it is the student's responsibility to ensure that these qualifications are accepted by the professional bodies.

General requirements for the Bachelor of Commerce non-professional accounting degree (ACC01)

Minimum number of credit points – 68; maximum number of credit points at 100 level – 30; minimum number of credit points in units at 300 level or above designated in the Schedule of Undergraduate Units as Commerce or Economics units – 18, which must include the following approved coherent study:

At least 12 credit points from ACCG329 **or** ACST305, ACCG350, ACCG352, ACCG353, ACST300, ECON335, ECON350, ECON360.

The following table lists the above units and their prerequisites in 2008:

As set out above, at least **12** of the 18 credit points you must complete must be chosen from the units listed above. The remaining **6** credit points must be chosen from 'Commerce; Economics' designated units at 300 level. (See list overleaf).

As you can see, apart from the 12 credit points at 300 level which you must pick from Table 1 above, there are no 'core units' as such in this program. It is the student's responsibility to check unit prerequisites to ensure that they are eligible for entry into the units they wish to study at 300 level to complete this course.
