ADVICE TO AUSTRALIAN STUDENTS REQUIRED TO TAKE A PRELIMINARY PROGRAM

This notice applies to Australian students¹ who are interested in applying for:

- Master of International Business
- MCom in Business
- MCom in Marketing, or
- MCom in Information Systems and Technology

Applications for the above programs are made through the Universities Admissions Centre (UAC) web: www.uac.edu.au/postgraduate.html tel: (02) 9752 0200.

Applicants who meet the entry standards for the MCom and MIB degree programs, but have not completed sufficient university level introductory business-related studies in a prior degree, will be advised by Macquarie University to complete a **preliminary program** before proceeding to the MCom or MIB degree programs. A preliminary program can be between one and four units for Australian students.

Upon completion of required preliminary units with pass grades or better, graduates will be able to proceed to the MCom or MIB program. This process will be administered internally and no further application through UAC is required.

The following preliminary units, or their equivalent, must be completed prior to enrolment in the MCom or MIB degree program.

All preliminary program units are available through the **Sydney Institute of Business and Technology** (SIBT) located on the Macquarie University campus at North Ryde.

To complete preliminary units, applicants must make arrangements for themselves through SIBT after receiving notification from Macquarie University/UAC of which preliminary units are required. Macquarie University does not arrange enrolment in preliminary units for students – it is a separate process from the MCom or MIB application through UAC.
